In the interim, our Greater New Jersey Annual Conference has established a local team ("GNJ Way Forward").

The GNJ Way Forward Team shall be comprised of a diverse group of clergy and 19 congregational leaders that represent the rich theological, cultural and generational diversity of GNJ. The team of 20 members includes GNJ leaders of the Board of Laity, Board of Global Ministries, Board of Trustees, Board of Ordained Ministries, Connectional Table, Council for Finance and Administration, Local Ethnic Concerns Committee, Reconciling Ministries, United Methodist Men, United Methodist Women, Wesleyan Covenant Association, and Youth Council.

Their task will be to identify and propose a plan to the Annual Conference Session by or before the May 2020. The proposal shall include, but not be limited to, how GNJ will:

- 1. support congregations in different contexts to be in ministry with the LGBTQI+ community,
- 2. respect and honor one another based on our theological and cultural differences, and
- 3. share our hopes and concerns with our United Methodist sisters and brothers around the world.

As we as the UMC of Summit collectively take this time in prayer and patience, we are reminded of the statement of welcome that has stood on our church's website for many years:

We invite all people to participate in our community and worship life, without insisting that they become like us in order to be acceptable, including but not limited to:

- believers and seekers
- those who hope for a better world and those who have lost hope
- conventional Christians and questioning skeptics
- women, men, children, and youth
- those of all sexual orientations and gender identities
- those of all races and cultures
- those of all income levels
- those of all classes and abilities


#### **EASTER FLOWERS 2019**
