"In the cold and snow of winter there's a spring that waits to be, unrevealed until its season, something God alone can see." — Hymn of Promise, UMH #707

I must confess—I love snow. When the forecast calls for snow, and most people seem to groan at the prospect of it, I eagerly await the first snowflakes and hope that we'll have at least a good few inches to enjoy. But there comes a point, usually in February, where I find myself both longing for one more good snowfall and for warm, sun-filled spring days. And where might God be inviting you to find moments of stillness and reflection, trusting that God is working beneath the surface?

This month, join us as we reflect on our stories to see where God has been at work in and through the events of our lives. Be a part of the good we are seeking to share with a hurting world through our many ministries. And then plan on joining us on Ash Wednesday as we enter into a season of contemplation with the reminder that no matter our brokenness or mortality, we are deeply loved. I am looking forward to journeying with you and discovering what hidden thing God is preparing in our midst.


