Flood Buckets:

As GNJ's Disaster Response team continues moving forward with the Ida relief effort, it has become apparent that there is a great need for more cleaning buckets. Over the next few weeks, UMC Summit will be collecting buckets and supplies. Here is a list of items needed:5 Gallon Buckets, 32-64 oz. bottles liquid laundry detergent,

16–40 oz. bottles liquid concentrate household cleaner, 16–34 oz. bottles liquid dish soap ,4–8 oz. pump spray air freshener, 6-14 oz. pump spray insect repellant, Scrub brushes, Re-usable cleaning wipes, Scouring pads, 50–100 ft. clothesline, 24 roll of heavy-duty trash bags (33–45 gallon sizes), N95 particulate respirator dust masks, Kitchen gloves, work gloves.

RENUNCIATION OF SIN AND PROFESSION OF FAITH

The pastor addresses parents and other sponsors:

On behalf of the whole Church, I ask you: Do you renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and repent of your sin?

I do.

Do you accept the freedom and power God gives you to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves?

I do.

Do you confess Jesus Christ as your Savior, put your whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as your Lord, in union with the Church which Christ has opened to people of all ages, nations, and races?

I do.

Will you nurture Ryleigh in Christ's holy Church, that by your teaching and example she may be guided to accept God's grace for herself, to profess her faith openly, and to lead a Christian life? **I will.**

The pastor addresses the congregation, and the congregation responds:

Do you, as Christ's body, the Church, reaffirm both your rejection of sin and your commitment to Christ?

We do.

Will you nurture one another in the Christian faith and life and include these persons now before you in your care?

With God's help we will proclaim the good news and live according to the example of Christ.

We will surround Ryleigh with a community of love and forgiveness, that she may grow in service to others.

We will pray for Ryleigh, that she may be a true disciple who walks in the way that leads to life.

*POURING & THANKSGIVING OVER THE WATER

All may stand.

The Lord be with you.

And also with you.

Let us pray:

Eternal Father, your mighty acts of salvation have been made known through water – from the moving of you Spirit upon the waters of Creation, to the deliverance of your people through the flood. You sent Jesus, nurtured in the water of a womb, baptized by John, and anointed by your Spirit. He called upon the disciples, to share in the baptism of his death and resurrection and to go out and make disciples of all the world. Pour out your Holy Spirit, bless this gift of water and *Ryleigh* who receives it, wash away her sins and clothe her in righteousness throughout her life, so that in dying and being raised with Christ, she may share in his final victory, through Jesus Christ our Lord we pray. **Amen.**
