To Mask or Not to Mask? Update on COVID19 Safety Protocols:

Masking in Worship

As of Monday, November 1st, 2021; the Administrative Council of SUMC agreed the church should follow CDC recommendations for masking during Sunday morning worship based on the published COVID -19 transmission rate for Union County. For **low and moderate** transmission rates, the CDC recommends all unvaccinated persons wear masks while vaccinated persons may attend unmasked (if so desired) as the risk for infection is considered low. For **substantial and high** transmission rates, the CDC recommends ALL persons wear a mask regardless of vaccination status to mitigate the risk of infection.

As of November 1st, the transmission rate in Union County was moderate. However, as of November 4th, the rate of transmission for COVID-19 in Union County has increased to "substantial". As a result, we will continue to require everyone to wear a mask during Sunday morning worship until the Union County transmission rate drops back down to moderate or low.
