Here in New Jersey we get to enjoy beautiful seasonal weather changes. At the United Methodist Church of Summit, the safety and well-being of our congregation and staff is one of our most important concerns. UMC Summit Youth Group Summer Mission Trip Christian Outreach Project Sunday, June 26th – Saturday, July 2nd, 2022

WHAT: The Christian Outreach Project is a non-profit organization, part of the Greater New Jersey Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church. For one week each summer, Christian Outreach Project sends groups of youth and adults to houses in local communities to provide housing repairs to homeowners who are unable to handle the projects themselves.

WHEN: The week for this mission trip is June 26-July 2, 2022.

WHERE: Groups stay at Camp Hoover, Stillwater, NJ

HOW: The cost for participants is \$420. This money goes to help offset the costs incurred through use of the Camp Hoover facilities, as well as to help pay for the supplies necessary to complete the projects undertaken. Scholarships are available from UMC Summit.

WHO: High School Youth who will have completed the 9th grade through 12th grade and are 14 years of age or older by June 26th, 2022; may participate. We are also looking for adult chaperones over the age of 22-years-old to accompany the group.
